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## 1. INTRODUCTION

This is a Special Counselling to fill vacancies in NITs and some IITs that have fallen vacant at the end of 7<sup>th</sup> round of seat allotment in the main counselling.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY FOR SPECIAL COUNSELLING

- All the candidates having remark "Permitted to fill choices Online...." on their AIEEE- 2009 Score Card issued by CBSE.
- The candidates who have taken admission but not withdrawn or cancelled their seats in NITs and IITs up to 7<sup>th</sup> round of main counseling are not eligible.

The candidates, who registered earlier in the main counselling (during June, 8 to 28, 2009) have to register afresh and have to submit fresh choices. The previously submitted choices will not be considered for this counselling. The candidates who have not registered and/or unlocked their choices in the main counseling can also register and submit their choices for this special counseling.

The admission process has been made ONLINE to make it more convenient to the candidates. In this process all the eligible candidates will have to exercise their choices for NITs and IITs during **September 9 – 13, 2009** from places of their convenience over internet. Allotment will be made on **15<sup>th</sup> September, 2009** and the allotment results will be displayed on this website. No individual allotment letters will be sent to the successful candidates. All the candidates who got allotment have to report at their respective NITs and IITs on or before **20<sup>th</sup> September 2009**, failing which their allotment shall automatically stand cancelled without any notice. The number of vacancies indicated during online registration and choice filling in each of the NITs may vary depending on the number of withdrawals/cancellations and admissions during the 7<sup>th</sup> round.

In case of any dispute arising out of the counseling process at any stage up to the final allocation of institution, the decision of Chairman, CCB shall be final.

In case of any legal dispute the jurisdiction will be **limited to Hyderabad courts only** (Lower, District and High Court) and will not be subject to the jurisdiction of any other courts outside Hyderabad.

## 3. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The admission process involves the following THREE steps:

- I. Online registration, choice filling and locking
- II. Seat Allotment
- III. Reporting at the allotted Institute

### I. ONLINE REGISTRATION, CHOICE FILLING AND LOCKING (September 9 – 13, 2009)

#### a) ONLINE REGISTRATION

During this step all the eligible candidates as indicated in **Item 2.** of this Information Brochure (**ELIGIBILITY FOR SPECIAL COUNSELLING**) on the basis of AIEEE-2009 results are required to register **ONLINE** through Internet ([www.ccb.nic.in](http://www.ccb.nic.in)) from places of their convenience.

The detailed procedure is described below:

1. A candidate has to open the website [www.ccb.nic.in](http://www.ccb.nic.in) and click on "**Registration**".
2. Engineering and Architecture streams will appear on the computer screen; click on the desired stream.

3. Register as a new candidate by clicking on “**New candidate!! Register here**” link. Read the instructions given on the screen and click on “**Register**”.
4. The candidate will register online by entering the following as indicated in the Admit card:
  - (a) Name
  - (b) Roll number
  - (c) Application number
  - (d) Date of Birth
  - This data submitted by the candidate will be verified with the AIEEE – 2009 data base of CBSE and if it matches then only the candidate will be permitted to proceed further and the candidate is required to give his own password.
  - The length of the password must be of EIGHT characters and must be a combination of alphabetic characters (small or capital), numeric characters and special characters. Password will be case sensitive.
  - Next time, the candidate can login directly with Roll number as login ID and the chosen password as Password. Whenever the candidates login, they have to LOGOUT at the end.
  - Candidates are advised to record/remember their password for all future Logins.
  - Confidentiality of the password is the sole responsibility of the candidate and all care must be taken to protect its security.
  - Candidates are advised not to disclose or share their password with anybody. Neither CCB nor NIC is responsible for violation or misuse of the password of the candidate.
  - If a candidate forgets his/her password, the additional information provided by the candidate at the time of registration will be used to get the new password. Hence, every candidate has to enter the required additional information as indicated in the registration form at the time of registration.
  - A candidate can change his/her password after login, if desired.
5. After login, the personal data of the candidate will automatically appear on the screen as per AIEEE-2009 data base. The candidate must verify his/her personal data. If there is any discrepancy, the candidate will be allowed **only once** to change his/her personal data of category, sub-category, etc. in the following ways:
  - Category can be changed from (SC/ST/OBC) to open but vice versa is not allowed.
  - Sub Category can be changed from SCPH to SC, STPH to ST, OBCPH to OBC and OPPH to OP, but vice versa is not allowed.
  - Change of gender is permitted if it is wrongly mentioned.
  - Candidates must enter their address for correspondence. Candidates may also enter their phone number, mobile number, email, etc.
  - The following changes are not permissible under any circumstances
    - Candidate's name
    - Mother's name
    - Father's name
    - Date of birth
    - State of Eligibility
  - Candidate can take a printout of the registration form with the above personal data.
  - It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to verify his/her personal data, including category, subcategory and gender as per documentary evidence. **By changing the category, sub category, and gender, eligibility of the candidate may change.** CCB/NIC is not responsible for any omissions in the details and its consequence thereafter.
  - ***If the personal data verified and submitted by the candidate is found to be wrong at the time of verification of certificates during reporting or at a later stage, the allotment of seat/admission is liable to be cancelled.***
  - Once this personal data is verified and submitted, the candidate will not be allowed to change the personal data under any circumstances.

## b) ONLINE CHOICE FILLING

During this step all the registered candidates are required to exercise their choices for NITs and some IIITs **without branch** in their order of preference. The branches will be allotted in the respective NITs after taking the admission.

The detailed procedure for online choice filling is described below:

1. The procedure for exercising choices and seeking pertinent information is guided through appropriate messages and tabs on the computer screen.
2. As per the eligibility of the candidate, information relating to institutions, disciplines (Engineering / Technology and Architecture / Planning) will be displayed.
3. The candidate can give as many numbers of choices in the order of preference as he/she wishes from the list of available institutes.
4. The candidates are permitted, if they so desire, to change or re-order their choices, delete earlier choices and add new choices any number of times until they lock their choices on or **before September 13, 2009 by 11.55PM.**

### c) LOCKING OF THE CHOICES

After filling the choices in the order of preference, the candidate must lock his/her choices. Without locking, the choices will not be processed for seat allotment. Hence, all the candidates **MUST LOCK** their choices on or before **September 13, 2009 by 11.55PM.**

However, candidates are advised to lock their choices well in advance instead of waiting till the dead line.

*If a candidate fails to LOCK his / her choices on or before September 13, 2009 by 11.55PM., the choices filled by the candidate will not be considered for seat allotment, and the candidate shall forego his / her right for consideration of his/her candidature for seat allotment.*

The button "Save and Continue", is to *save* the filled choices and *continue* for filling some more choices, the "Save and Exit" button is to *save* the filled choices and *exit* from the choice filling, "Logout" button is for logging out from the current session. ***These three buttons do not lock the choices filled by the candidate.***

### **LOCKING PROCEDURE**

In order to lock the choices, the candidate has to click on the "CHOICE LOCKING" button only. After clicking on it, "LOCKING AGREEMENT" message will be displayed with two options "I agree to lock my choices" and "I do not agree to lock my choices". If "I agree to lock my choices" button is clicked, a prompt for entering the password will be displayed. After entering the password, the candidate has to click on "LOCK MY CHOICES". Then a popup window with few warning messages along with two buttons "CANCEL" and "OK" will be displayed. By clicking on "OK" button, the choices will be locked and a printable version of the choices containing "Choice status : LOCKED" and "an auto unique id" will be generated. It is mandatory to take a print-out of these locked choices.

After locking of the choices, the candidates can not change their choices under any circumstances.

After locking the choices, if a candidate logs in again, then the locked choices given by the candidate only will be displayed.

## **II. SEAT ALLOTMENT**

The Home State (HS) quota seats are merged into All India (AI) quota and subcategory seats are merged with the corresponding category seats.

The choices submitted by the candidates will be processed centrally and Institute will be allotted in the order of merit based on their locked choices on **September 15, 2009 2009**. The allotment result will be available on the website [www.ccb.nic.in](http://www.ccb.nic.in). No individual allotment letters will be sent to the successful candidates.

The branches will be allotted in the respective institutes later by performing internal sliding.

*If a candidate fails to satisfy the minimum educational qualifications prescribed (10 + 2 or equivalent), his / her allotment of the seat shall automatically stand cancelled.*

### **III. REPORTING AT THE ALLOTTED INSTITUTE (September 16 - 20, 2009)**

All the candidates who are allotted seats shall report physically at their allotted institute during the office hours from **September 16 - 20, 2009**.

**If a candidate fails to report physically at his/her allotted institute latest by September 20, 2009, his/her provisional allotment shall automatically stand cancelled without any prior notice.**

#### **Reporting Procedure**

The successful candidates have to report to their allotted institute for reporting. The detailed procedure is as follows:

#### **Verification of Documents**

The following documents and credentials in **original** will be required:

- 1) Score Card issued by CBSE/ Admit Card of AIEEE-2009.
- 2) Class X (High School) Board Certificate as proof of date of birth.
- 3) Pass Certificate and Marks sheet of qualifying examination.
- 4) Certificate of category (OBC / SC / ST), if applicable, issued by the competent authority (Annexure I / II).
- 5) Certificate for Physically Challenged (PH) issued on or after January 1, 2009 (Annexure III).
- 6) Passport of the candidates who have passed qualifying examination from outside India for determination of the State of Eligibility.
- 7) Proof of place of examination centre of the final examination from the National Open School for candidates having Senior Secondary Certificate for determination of the State of Eligibility.

*Note: If the original certificates are not in Hindi / English, duly certified Hindi / English version / translation of such certificates will be required.*

*If the personal data viz. category, subcategory, state of eligibility and gender submitted by the candidate at the time of registration is found to be wrong at the time of verification of the original certificates in reporting at allotted institutions, his / her allotment of the seat is liable to be cancelled.*

**FEE PAYMENT:** The candidates who are allotted seats have to pay the fee as per the respective allotted institute fee structure.

#### **4. CANCELLATION & REFUND**

If a candidate cancels his/her admission after reporting at the allotted institution, the candidate has to approach the allotted institute for refund. The refund will be made as per the rules of the allotted institute.

#### **5 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

##### **5.1 Academic Qualifications**

The academic qualifications as prescribed in Information Bulletin and Application Form of AIEEE-2009 are applicable for this counselling. These are reproduced below.

- The minimum academic qualification for admission through AIEEE-2009 is a pass in the final examination of 10+2 (Class XII), or its equivalent, referred to as the qualifying examination. In case they fail to submit the proof of passing in the qualifying examination, their admission will stand cancelled.
- Subject combinations required in the qualifying examination for admission to B.E. / B.Tech and B.Arch. / B.Planning Courses shall be as under (Table 1):

**Table 1: Subject Combinations in the Qualifying Examination**

Course	Compulsory	Any one of the Optional Subjects
B.E. / B.Tech.	Physics & Mathematics	Chemistry, Bio-technology, Computer Science, Biology
B.Arch / B. Planning**	Mathematics with 50% marks in aggregate at 10+2 level	

This is as per decision of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).

\*\*Provisionally as per the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and directive received from Ministry of Human Resource Development.

## 5.2 List of Qualifying Examinations

- The 10+2 level examination of any recognized Central / State Board of Secondary Examination, such as Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, and Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi.
- Intermediate or two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized Board / University.
- Final Examination of the two-year course of the Joint Services Wing of the National Defense Academy.
- Any Public School / Board / University Examination in India or in foreign countries recognized by the Association of Indian Universities as equivalent to 10+2 system.
- H.S.C. Vocational Examination.
- A pass grade in the Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Open School with a minimum of five subjects. Proof of place of examination centre of the final examination from the National Open School will be required for determination of State of Eligibility.
- 3 or 4-year diploma recognized by AICTE or a State Board of Technical Education.

## 6. RESERVATION OF SEATS

Some seats in NITs, are reserved for OBC, SC, ST and PH candidates.

The candidates as per AIEEE 2009 records shall only be considered as OBC/SC/ST for Central Counselling. OBC candidates will have to satisfy the caste and Creamy Layer requirements detailed on the following National Commission for Backward Classes (ncbc) websites:

### 6.1 Category Rules

There are four vertical categories, namely, Open (OP), Other Backward Class (OBC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Scheduled Caste (SC).

If a candidate is not able to produce required category certificate (OBC / SC / ST) or the certificate is found invalid, his / her category will be changed to OP category.

**Note:** The Social Welfare Department of Government of Maharashtra will validate certificate for OBC, SC and ST category issued from Maharashtra State to be obtained in CCB format (Annexure II & III). It is therefore compulsory for the candidates to submit validity certificate alongwith category certificate (in CCB format).
