### Announcement of Supernumerary Round of Counselling

With reference to letter No. F.26-3/2010/TSIII dated 02.08.2011 from MHRD and further directives, CCB(AIEEE-2011) is hereby announcing Supernumerary round of Counselling for filling of declared supernumerary seats in non- NIT states/UTs of 2007. The details of the proposed supernumerary round are given below:

## 2. Tentative Schedule of Supernumerary Round

ONLINE Registration and williness for participation	August 17 to August 18, 2011 up to 5PM	Candidates of only the above states/UTs can participate for respective (Home) NITs. They can use internet facility from any place of convenience. Candidates have to register afresh then login to CCB website using their password. They shall give willingness for participation. Only those candidates who give willingness for participation will be considered for allotment.

Personally reporting to allotment Institute against the supernumerary round of allotment	August 19 to August 21, 2011	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Get the documents verified</li> <li>• Show surrender receipt letter (if applicable) and pay remaining fee/ FULL fee( for fresh candidates)</li> <li>• Give within-institute branch choices</li> <li>• Start attending classes immediately. Candidates not reporting will lose their seat allotment automatically.</li> </ul>

Branch allocation to be done latter by respective NITs after the end of admission process

## 3. Eligibility of candidates for Supernumerary round

### A. Eligible candidates

**Only those eligible candidates having their State of Eligibility as per States or UTs mentioned in Para 1 AND who satisfy the criterion indicated below are eligible for seats under HOME STATE supernumerary quota of the respective NITs:**

- i. Those registered candidates who did not get any seat allotment in **first five rounds** and remained **unallotted**.
- ii. Those who duly surrendered their seat after the third round but did not get any allotment thereafter

- iii. Candidates who reported against allotted seat to Reporting Centres or Participating Institutes but seat cancelled due to change in category et., and are still un-allotted
- iv. Candidates who did not report against an allotment in earlier rounds, whether to a NIT or a non-NIT.
- v. Candidates who got allotment but cancelled after reporting to Reporting Center or Participating Institute
- vi. Those eligible candidates who did not register during June 11-23,2011 can register afresh.

**B. Not Eligible Candidates**

- i. **Candidates who have already taken admission in any NIT are NOT eligible.**

## 6. Allotment of Supernumerary seats

- Candidates having eligibility as per para 3, shall register and give willingness for participation. This can be done online after logging to CCB website: ccb.nic.in using their password from the place of their convenience. Candidates registering and giving willingness will only be considered for the allotment of supernumerary seats.
- Allotment of seat in the respective NITs will be done on NO BRANCH basis based on AIR .
- Branch will be allotted to the candidates based on inter-se-merit (AIR) after reporting to respective NIT and completing the various formalities of reporting

## 7. Rules and Regulations

The rules regarding category, subcategory, age, state of eligibility, qualifications, original document, restrictions etc. are the same as those specified in CCB Information Brochure. Candidates after allotment can directly get admitted in the allotted Institute.
